

Modifying SNMP Access

The **SNMP Access** tab allows you to set the read-only and read-write passwords. Simply type in and confirm a password, and then click **Update**.

The CSN installs the Net-SNMP command line tool for use in collecting SNMP data from the MIB. The tool utilizes standard SNMP commands like 'snmpwalk', 'snmpget' and 'snmpset'. For read-only commands (snmpwalk, snmpget), the CSN expects a password of 'public' by default. For write commands, it expects a 'private' password by default. The default passwords may be updated on the **SNMP Access** tab.
