

Editing User Access

The **User Access** tab allows you to reset the password to access the CSN console. Enter the current password, and then enter and confirm a new password. Click **Save** to save your changes.

The username used to access the CSN console is 'admin'. The admin password can be updated from the User Access link under the Cluster Services tab. The default password is 'caringo'. Characters are obscured when entered on the page so double entry is required to ensure accuracy. The obscured character count does not necessarily correspond to the number of characters in the password.
