

Running and Managing the CSN

All configuration of the CSN can be done from the [Netmail Administration Console](#). You can make both basic configuration changes as well as perform more complex functions like creating manual configuration backups or changing Netmail Store software versions. Use the **Cluster Services** object in the Netmail Administration Console to configure the CSN through the [Configuration](#), [SNMP Access](#), [Netboot Management](#), [User Access](#), [Backup and Restore](#), and [SCSP Proxy](#) tabs.

Note: *Concurrent CSN updates made on a single screen of the Console from two or more browser sessions are not supported. Administrators should take care to ensure they are looking at a current version of the saved configuration prior to submitting any changes.*
